Food Trailer Debt Forgiveness

At the July 21st business meeting, the following resolution was presented to be discussed for consideration at our August 18th business meeting:

WHEREAS, the Festival Committee borrowed money from the Building Corporation to purchase a Food Trailer, and

WHEREAS, the Festival Committee agreed that 50% of the Food Trailer profits would be used to retire the Building Corporation debt, and

WHEREAS, the Festival Committee has worked diligently for five years at activities involving the Food Trailer, and

WEREAS, the Food Trailer has proven to be a positive, visible sign of our council at these activities, and

WHEREAS, there is money still owed to the Building Corporation, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Building Corporation agrees that the remaining money still owed by the Festival Committee be forgiven and that all future profits from activities involving the Food Trailer be turned over to the Financial Secretary for deposit into the council General Fund.
